ARTICLE 51A

- (e) to promote harmony and the spirit of common brotherhood amongst all the people of India transcending religious linguistic and regional or sectional diversities; to renounce practices derogatory to the dignity of women;

- (g) to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers, wild life and to have compassion for living creatures;
- (h) to develop the scientific temper, humanism and the spirit of inquiry and reform;
- (i) to safeguard public property and to abjure violence;
- (j) to strive towards excellence in all spheres of individual and collective activity so that the nation constantly rises to higher levels of endeavor and achievement

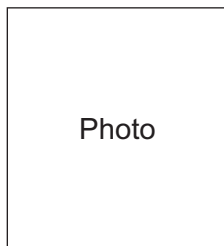

Curriculum & Co Curriculum Activities

The school follows the syllabus prescribed by the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) The medium of instruction is English. Activities such as yoga, dance, music, drama, painting, karate are regularly organised. - ❖ Help them appreciate in all forms. Enable them to understand themselves better and to instill confidence in themselves.
- ❖ Help them to master cheering attitude and skill which will benefit their society and nation.
- ❖ Make them aware of their social responsibilities and train them to be of service at all times in their life.

Admissions And Withdrawals

- 1) Application for admission is to be made in prescribed form by buying the school prospectus from the office.
- 2) Child who has completed three years of age can be admitted to NURSERY CLASS.
- 3) School leaving certificate must be submitted from the last school attended.
- 4) In case of first time admission original Birth Certificate has to be submitted along with the admission form.
- 5) One month's notice in writing is to be given before the withdrawal of the pupil.
- 6) Those who leave in the month of June must pay the fees of April and May.
- 7) No leaving certificates is issued until all dues are paid.

DISCIPLINE

- ❖ Students must be regular and punctual in their attendance, earnest in their studies, polished in their manners and faithful to the discipline of the school.
- ❖ Students must wear their proper school uniform.
- ❖ Students must maintain complete silence and perfect discipline in the school working hours. They must walk in silence and in a single line while walking in the corridors.
- ❖ Students must keep their classrooms and school premises clean.
- ❖ Students must be kind and gentle in their behavior towards other students.

LEAVE OF ABSENCE

- ❖ Parents are requested not to ask for special leave. If the child is out during vacation , they must see that the child returns in time.
- ❖ Students suffering from an infectious disease must bring a doctor's certificate declaring fitness when returning to school.
- ❖ A student who has been absent must bring a note in the calendar from the parent or guardian.
- ❖ The principal should be informed in case, a student is likely to be absent from school for more than a week due to illness.
- ❖ If absence is for three or more days, a doctor's certificate should be submitted in case the child is ill.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARENTS

- ❖ When writing to the Principal, parents are requested to mention the name, standard, division in which the student is studying.
- ❖ Any change in address or telephone number should be immediately intimated to the school office and the similar changes should be shown in the school calender and ID Card.
- ❖ Parents should see that the child attends the school regularly.
- ❖ Children are expected to come to school in full uniform, finger nails cut, hair trimmed and well combed.
- ❖ Parents should see that the child wears the ID Card daily to school.
- ❖ Parents are expected to send daily, the school calender, a clean napkin and proper books.
- ❖ Parents are expected to check the school calender daily.

9. Parents cannot hold the school authorities / transport authorities responsible for any mishap arising due to parents negligence or disobeying any transport rules mentioned here.

- a) A written request must be submitted by the parent.
- b) The register maintained in the school office for this purpose must be signed by the parent.
- c) Student's gate pass must be obtained from the school office and shown at the school gate.
- d) If possible do inform the bus attendant about it.

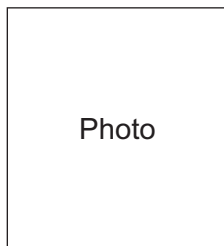
